Assignment Title: Recruitment of 18 Construction Sites Supervisors

The GPE-funded Liberia Learning Foundations Project (LLF) aims to improve access to ECE services in the targeted countries of Bomi, Grand Kru, Maryland, Rivercess, River Gee and Sinoe. With high poverty rates and low education outcomes within these six counties, the need for multiple and sustained interventions is warranted. To ensure that young people can learn, thrive and succeed, the LLF Project complements the GPE-funded Getting to Best in Education Project activities with a focus on building ECE classrooms and WASH facilities, providing teaching and learning materials, and expanding an accelerated learning program (ALP) for overage ECE students.

The Ministry of Education, in an effort to strengthen its Project Delivery Team (PDT) for the effective implementation of this project, intends to use part of the proceeds of this Grant to pay for services to be provided by 18 Construction sites Supervisors.

Objectives of the Assignment

He or she will lead, manage, and coordinate tasks related to supervision of construction works, and any Engineering services to be provided for the implementation of the LLF Project. He/she will ensure that the construction supervision works are performed in a fully professional, transparent, and ethical manner, and in line with regulations and guidelines of the project.

Deliverables

These include monthly, bi-monthly, quarterly, semi-annual, and annual progress reports. The reports will describe all activities performed throughout the reporting period; and (ii) inputs covering all the project activities by the Contractors.

Other Terms/Job Relationships

The Construction Site Supervisors will report through the LLF Deputy Project Coordinator to the CMT(Construction Management Team) on all LLF Project related matters. He/she will collaborate with key project stakeholders in the execution of his/her responsibilities. These include MoE staff, PDT, DPE, MPW, Contractors, the project beneficiaries and the World Bank.

Job Location

The Construction Site Supervisors will be duty station outside of Monrovia and work with in his or her assigned County. The MoE will provide the necessary logistical support for the performance of the assignment.

Duration

The position of Construction Site Supervisors is a full-time job for Ten (10) Month's duration. The appointment will initially be for Ten Months and with a possibility of extension based on performance.

Selection will be in accordance with the Individual Consultant Selection (ICS) Method set out in the World Bank New Procurement Regulations, Fourth Edition, November, 2020, and the [Bank Policy on Corrupt and Fraudulent Practices](#)

QUALIFICATIONS Criteria

The Construction Site Supervisor must have the following:

- High school diploma or equivalent is required. A Bachelor degree in construction is an added advantage.
- Technical or vocational certificate/diploma/ AA Degree in Civil or Architecture Engineering Technology, construction, project management or in a relevant engineering discipline.
- Recognized and valid License in one of the trades (carpentry, plumbing, welding, or similar) is an asset.
- At least Five (5) years of progressively responsive experience in construction, and engineering work.
- Experience in school constructions and supervision is highly desirable.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills, including an impeccable mastery of the English language;
- Good organization skills and the ability to multitask on several projects simultaneously;
- He should have excellent command of verbal and written English and a strong attention to detail including sensitivity to local traditional laws;
- Excellent oral and written communication skills, and familiarity with relevant computer software (MS Word, PowerPoint, Excel, etc).
- He / she should have excellent command on how to read and understanding drawings, specifications and interpretations.
